About the series

Mighty Yeti Studios is casting voice actors for Classtronauts, a CG-animated preschool series about kids from around the world attending school in space.

The show blends warmth, humor, and curiosity with early learning (STEM + social-emotional skills), creating a safe and joyful experience for young audiences.

We are building a diverse, global cast with an emphasis on authentic, natural performances.

Production & Casting Details

Recording:

- Remote (home studio acceptable)
- Clean, broadcast-quality audio required
- Live direction (Zoom/Source Connect) or self-record

Compensation:

- ~\$100 per session (30–60 min)
- Covers episodes, shorts, and pickups
- Additional sessions scheduled as needed



Casting Priorities:

- Authenticity of voice and accent
- Warm, clear delivery for preschool audience
- Distinct, memorable character voices
- Ability to grow with a long-term series
- **Singing ability is a plus**

Accent Direction:

- We are seeking actors who can authentically perform the required accents.
- Actors with a personal or cultural connection to the role are strongly encouraged to submit. Performances should feel natural, respectful, and non-caricatured.

Selected actors may be invited to return for ongoing episodes, shorts, and related content.

IQ-4U (Lead Teacher)

- Female-presenting voice
- Adult (30s–50s voice range)
- Light British accent (RP or soft regional, globally accessible)

Tone:

Warm, intelligent, musical, encouraging

Notes:

- Gentle authority with warmth
- Slight sing-song quality
- Central emotional anchor of the show

A musical robot educator with the heart of Mary Poppins and the logic of C-3PO, IQ-4U is the franchise anchor of Classtronauts. Her warmth, authority, and signature songs create a trusted preschool brand character designed to extend seamlessly across series, shorts, and interactive platforms.

- Neutral accent

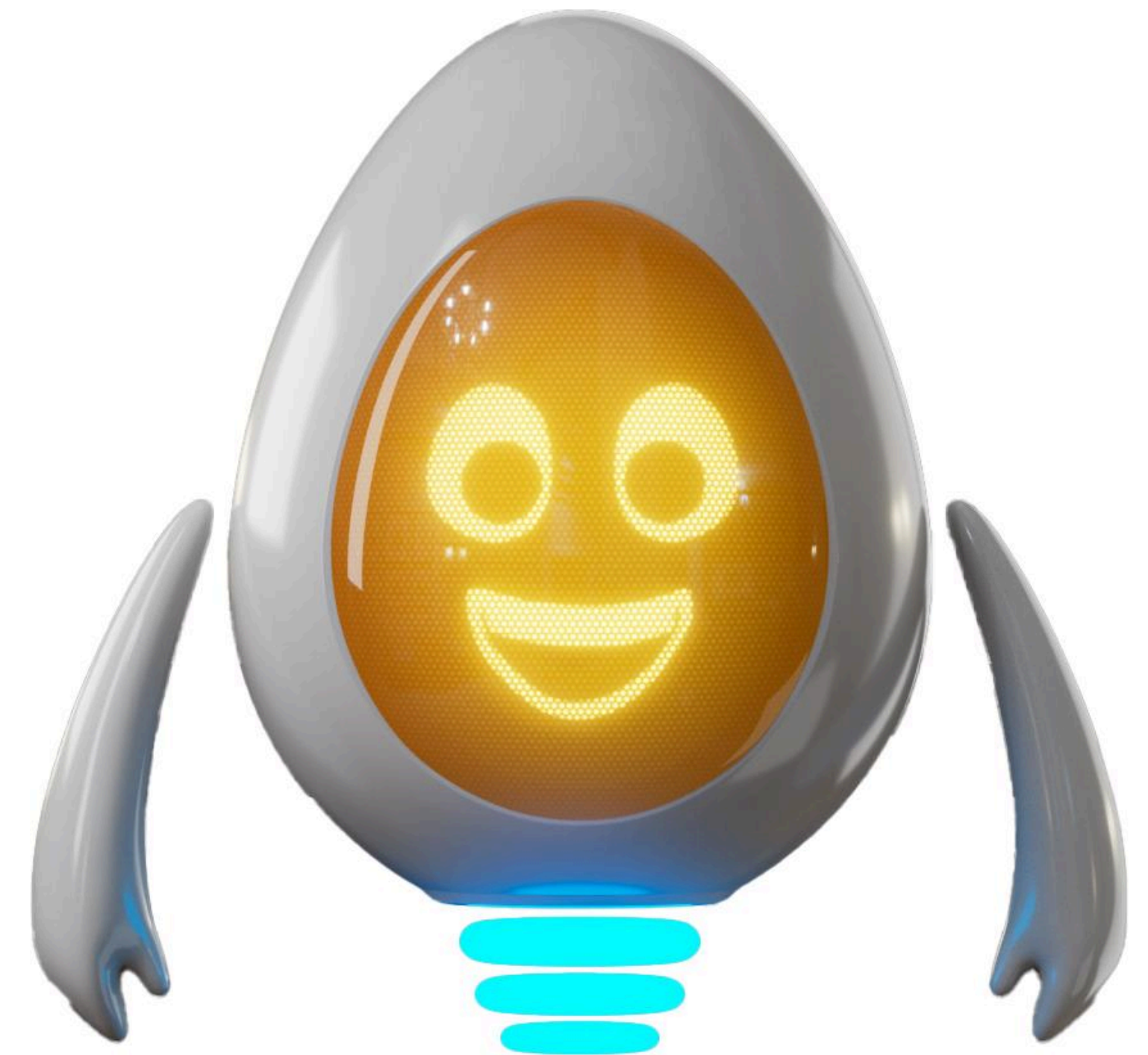
Tone:

Notes:

- Warm and reassuring
- Soft natural chuckle
- Subtle humor
- Feels like a calm, trusted mentor

- Neutral accent

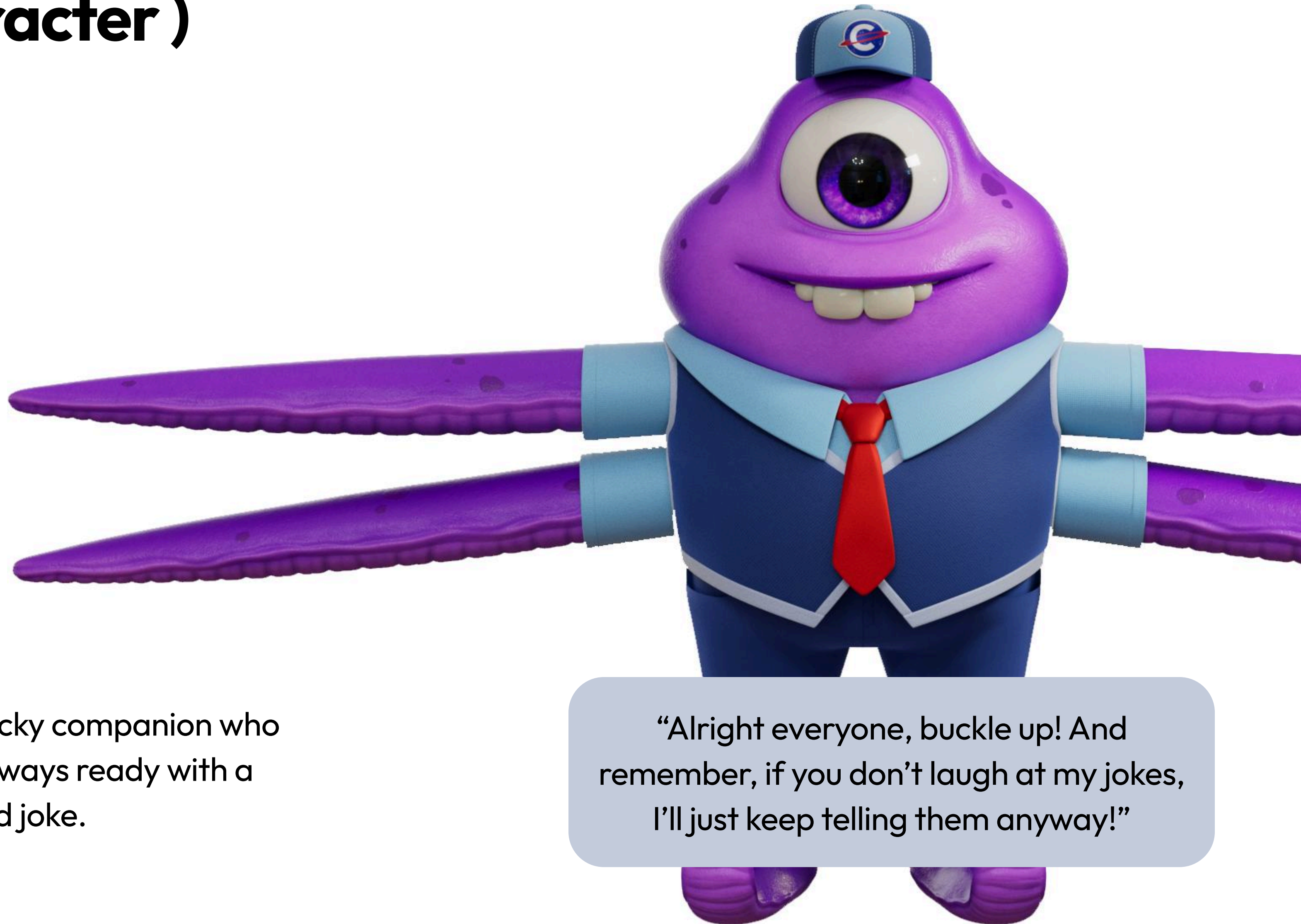
Tone:

“Alright everyone, buckle up! And remember, if you don’t laugh at my jokes, I’ll just keep telling them anyway!”

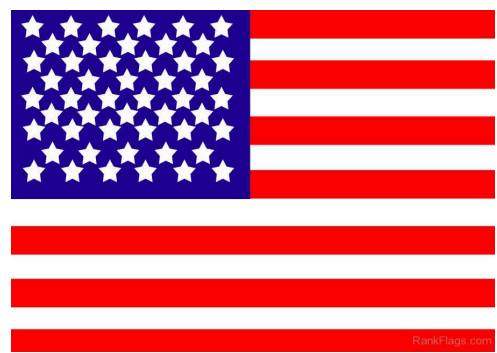
Theo

Kind, empathetic, emotionally grounded

Friendly, thoughtful, and deeply empathetic, Kofi is the glue that holds the team together. Proudly representing West Africa, he reminds his classmates that collaboration and understanding are just as important as science.

- Light Chinese accent (authentic, natural)

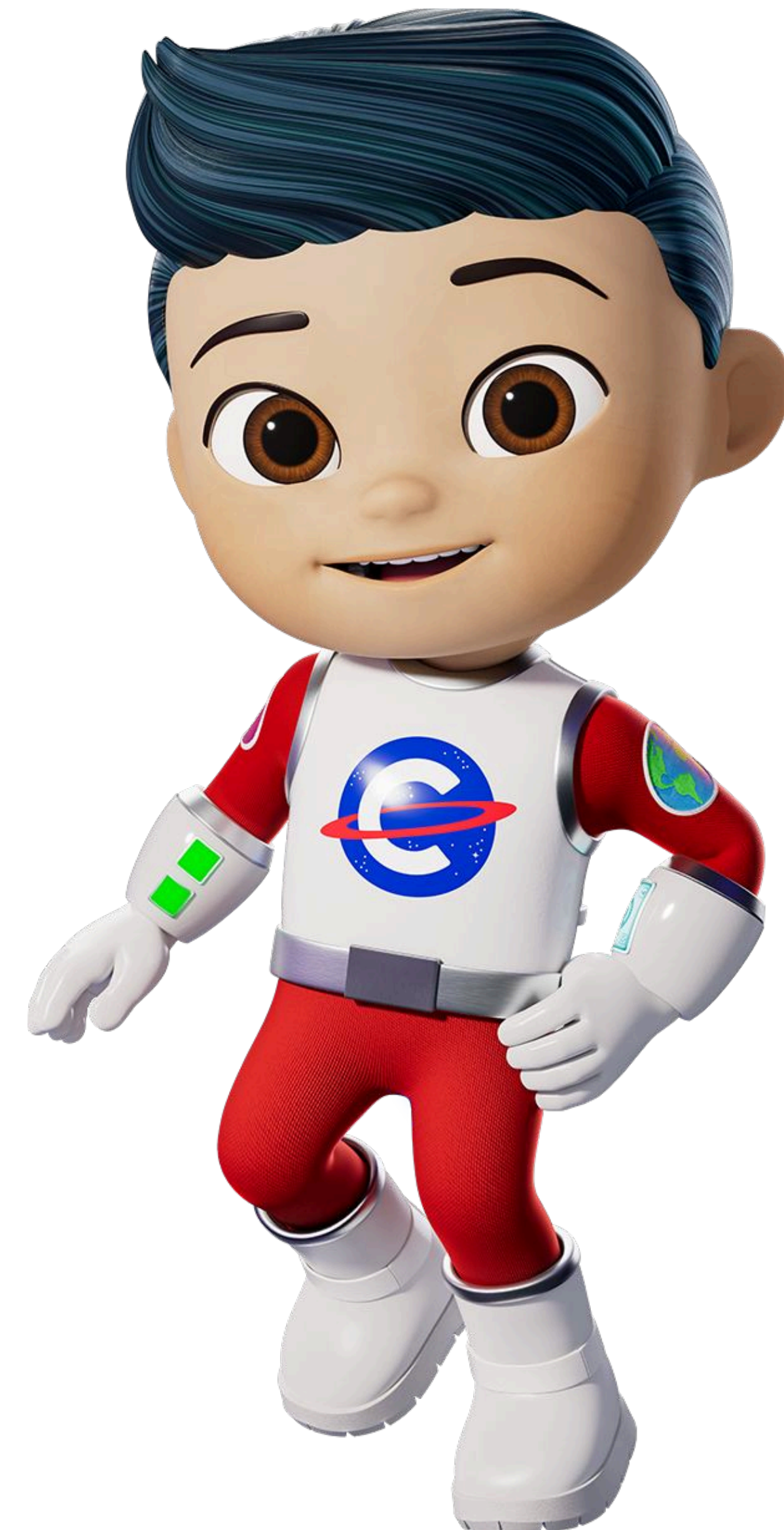
Tone:

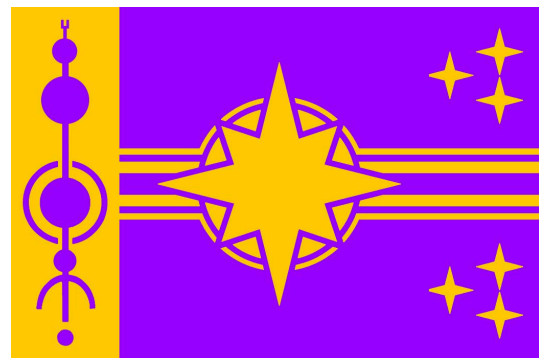
Zibu

‘figuring it out’?”



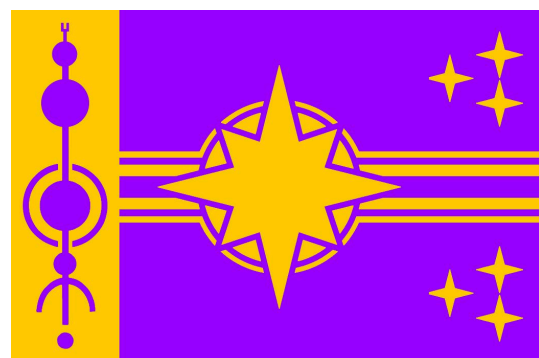
Zibu
